CYBR-H, a project led by Erium (Cyber Investigation) and Anozr Way, wins France 2030 call for proposals to reduce human cyber risk

Erium, expert in cybersecurity and publisher of solutions (including Cyber Investigation) and Anozr Way, specialized in the management of human cyber risks and the identification of human vulnerabilities, are winners of the France 2030 call for projects in the "Development of critical innovative technologies" category. The CYBR-H project, based on the complementary nature of the two companies' platforms, aims to reduce human cyber risk.

Launched in July 2023, the France 2030 call for projects aims to assess cybersecurity and accelerate innovation for products and services to effectively implement the new NIS 2 and DORA regulations.

The CYBR-H project aims to measure, manage and reduce human cyber risk. Erium and Anozr Way, market leaders in France, offer complementary software platforms:

- Erium reinforces employees' cybersecurity culture, thanks to its playful training platform Cyber Investigation, which helps all users, but also technical experts and developers, to understand the cyber risks incurred in professional and personal life. It includes videos, quizzes, quick-reflex cards and challenges covering a range of cyber risks.

- Anozr Way's platform, AY PeopleSight, enables CISOs to manage their company's human cyber risk and prevent social engineering attacks on managers and employees.

A major challenge: cyber prevention and protection for individuals and organizations

While 95% of cyber attacks are still based on human failings, CYBR-H enables employees and managers to become key players in the defense of their organization and their digital life. By combining Cyber Investigation and AY PeopleSight, CYBR-H is positioned as the global European solution for assessing human factor risks, mobilizing individuals and deploying customized training actions to combat social engineering, fraud and cyber attacks.
